- Recycling paper and cardboard from our office and warehousing activities
- Distribution in the major cities done at night when possible
- Replace 50 % of the diesel trucks with electric trucks within our distribution network in the major cities by the end of 2020
- Strive to use trucks with the latest Euro standards
- Encourage usage of alternative fuels like HVO and hydrogen in our international road transport system
- Actively move goods from road to sea and rail whenever possible. If combination freights within sea/rail/road can replace road alone, we will do so
